



## **Examinations - Severe Weather Questions and Answers:**

### **If I have an exam coming soon, what should I do?**

Keep revising! The exams timetable is going ahead as planned. If you think our school may be affected by the weather, visit our website or contact us on 01446 403500

- **What should I do if my school is closed?**

If your school has to close, updates will be made via local radio, sms messages and the school website. The exams officer will explain the situation to the Examination Board. The school will try to contact you if we are making other arrangements, such as using an alternative location although this is unlikely.

The school may open for exams only, so please check our school's website or contact us on 01446 403500 to check this.

- **What if I can't reach school, even though it is open?**

You need to let us know your circumstances. If the examination unit you were going to sit is available again in May / June, you will have the opportunity to sit it then.

- **I'm worried that I'll be late arriving at my exam, if I have transport problems. Does that mean I won't be able to take the exam?**

You need to make every effort to arrive at your examination centre on time, and to get there safely as soon as you possibly can, even if it looks as though you might be a little late. There is some leeway when, if you are late, you will still be allowed to sit your exam.

Contact us to let us know if you think you might be late, and make sure that you avoid contact with any candidates who may have come out early from your exam.
